Many will qualify to receive rebate checks that can help pay bills (est. May):

If struggling as a small business or sole proprietor, can apply for PPP:

- Pay increased to be 150% of prior max

- IRA distributions free from penalty, taxes paid over 3-years, repayment available
- Employer-plan loan availability doubled to \$100k and allows up to 100% vested access (was 50%), whichever is lower
